- 67 Deodar Cedar- Holds the title as the largest of its species in California

- 73 English Hawthorn- Remembers the eightieth anniversary of the founding of the first Girl Scout troop in the United States

- 113 Japanese Flowering Cherry- Marks the centennial of President Franklin Roosevelt's birth

- 132 Maidenhair Tree- Holds the title as the largest of its species in California
- 143 Montezuma Cypress- Holds the title as the largest of its species in California
- 157 Pineapple Guava- Honors the U.S. Geological Survey

- 183 Southern Magnolia- Civil war memorial trees, Andersonville, GA

- 199 Tulip Tree- Holds the title as the largest of its species in California, Civil war memorial trees, Five Forks, VA

- 201 Valencia Orange- Holds the title as the largest of its species in the nation
- 202 Valley Oak- Honor the contributions to the state's history and culture by California's Native Americans
