



Location of Legislative Functions and Legislative Offices

Alabama	Legislature relocated to the State House (former Highway Department Building) in 1985 during renovation of the Capitol. Legislators' offices, legislative chambers, and committee rooms are located in the State House.
Alaska	Terry Miller Legislative Office Building (an old school that was renovated in 1998 for the legislature) houses the Legislative Affairs Agency (central legislative staff). Legislative chambers, offices, and committee rooms are located in the Capitol. Fiscal offices are located in a small building near the capitol. Audit is located in a state office building.
Arizona	Two separate buildings for the House and Senate were constructed in 1960 (The legislative chambers and committee rooms are in these buildings). (Original capitol Building is used as a museum)
Arkansas	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. The Bureau of Legislative Reference is located in 1 Capitol Mall adjacent to the Capitol.
California	Legislative chambers, some leaders' offices, and some committee rooms are located in the capitol. Most legislators' offices are located in a 6-floor annex (added in 1952). Some committee offices and central legislative staff are located in the Legislative Office Building.
Colorado	Legislative chambers, leaders' offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. For all other legislators, their desk on the floor of the legislative chamber is considered their office. Some central legislative staff are located in a building across the street from the capitol.
Connecticut	Legislative sessions and committee sessions are held in the capitol. Legislative leaders' offices are also located in the Capitol. A legislative office building (constructed in 1987) houses member offices, central staff offices, the legislative library and a cafeteria.
Delaware	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. Wings were added to the east side of the Capitol building so that each member of the General Assembly would have his/her own office in 1993-94.
Florida	A legislative office building (constructed in 1978) houses all legislative functions. It is called the "New Capitol" and the old capitol is used as a museum. The House and Senate also have office buildings for member and staff offices.
Georgia	Legislative chambers and committee rooms are located in the capitol. House and Senate offices are located in separate buildings.
Hawaii	A separate building (Leiopapa a Kamehameha Building) was constructed to house all functions of the House and Senate, including chamber operations. Legislative chambers and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Idaho	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. During

	the renovation (2001-09) two, 1-story underground wings were constructed to provide additional space for committee hearing rooms and offices.
Illinois	Legislative chambers and committee rooms are located in the capitol. Senators and House leadership is in Capitol and all other House members are in the Stratton Bldg (constructed in 1955).
Indiana	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Iowa	Legislative chambers, leaders' offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. For all other legislators, their desk on the floor of the legislative chamber is considered their office. Capitol café on the ground floor. LSA, and the legislative Ombudsman together control 3 floors of the old Historical building.
Kansas	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the statehouse. (Statehouse restoration was completed in 2014)
Kentucky	Legislative chambers and committee rooms are located in the capitol. Legislative offices are located in the Capitol Annex.
Louisiana	Constructed an underground addition in the 1970s for Senate legislative offices and committee hearing rooms. The basement was renovated for House office space and committee hearing rooms.
Maine	Legislative chambers, leaders' offices, IT staff, statute revisor's office, a few other central staff, and committee rooms are located in the capitol. The Office of Policy and Legal Analysis; Office of Program Evaluation, some other central staff offices and the cafeteria are located in the Cross Office Building.
Maryland	Legislative chambers and leaders' offices are located in the Capitol. State Senators' offices located in the James Senate Office Building. Senate Committee offices and hearing rooms are located in the Miller Senate Building. State Delegates' offices, committee offices and hearing rooms are located in the House Office Building. The legislative Services Building houses the Department of Legislative Services, legislative library, and the Joint Committee Hearing Room.
Massachusetts	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the State House.
Michigan	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the Capitol. Additional office space is located in the Binsfeld building (Senate offices) and the Anderson House office building, the Victor Center, and Boji Tower
Minnesota	Legislative chambers and committee rooms are located in the capitol. The offices for some Senators (and their staff) and all Representatives (and their staff) are in the State Office Buildings.
Mississippi	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Missouri	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Montana	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Nebraska	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Nevada	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the Legislative Building. All Legislators' offices are in the Legislative Building. Legislative Counsel Bureau staff housed in a building across the street from the Legislative Building.
New Hampshire	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the State House. The legislative office building (completed in 1975) provides office space and committee rooms.
New Jersey	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the State House. Some legislators' offices are in the south addition of the State House. A separate statehouse annex (constructed 1927-1930) holds some legislator offices and the Supreme Court Chamber.

New Mexico	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the Capitol (known as the Roundhouse)
New York	Assembly and Senate chambers are located in the Capitol Building. Most Assembly offices are in the Capitol, Legislative Office Building and Agency Building 4.
North Carolina	House and Senate chambers are in the Legislative Building (constructed in 1982). The building also houses about half of the General Assembly members and a portion of the central staff. The Legislative Office Building houses the remaining members and staff. Ceremonial legislative chambers are located in the Capitol.
North Dakota	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Ohio	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the statehouse. Converted existing space in an adjacent state building into legislative offices and built an atrium to connect the two structures. A new government office building was constructed, which now houses the Governor's Office, some Administration Departments, the Legislative Service Commission and all members and staff of the House. Senate members and staff are housed in the Statehouse Senate Building, a part of the Statehouse.
Oklahoma	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Oregon	Legislative chambers, offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Pennsylvania	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. A complete addition to the back of the capitol building houses staff, members and committee rooms. Some offices are in the Capitol, others are in the East Wing, Ryan Office Bldg, and Irvis Office Bldg.
Rhode Island	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
South Carolina	Legislative chambers are located in the statehouse. The Senate and House each have their own office building.
South Dakota	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol.
Tennessee	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. Legislative offices are in the underground Legislative Plaza on the south side of the Capitol.
Texas	Legislative chambers and some offices are located in the capitol. An underground extension (completed in 1995) houses legislators and staff and committee rooms. 1/3 of Senators and 2/3 of House members' offices are in the underground Capitol Extension.
Utah	Legislative chambers and some offices are located in the capitol. Office buildings for both the House and Senate were constructed 2001-04.
Vermont	Legislative chambers, leaders' offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. For all other legislators, their desk on the floor of the legislative chamber is considered their office. Joint fiscal office is in One Baldwin Street.
Virginia	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. The visitor's center, cafe and gift shop are located in the underground extension to the capitol. There are several committee rooms and 140 legislators have offices in the General Assembly Building. An additional café is located in the General Assembly Building.
Washington	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. The majority of legislators have offices in adjacent Senate and House office buildings.
West Virginia	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. Most members private offices are located in the East (House of Delegates) and West (State Senate) Wings.

Wisconsin	Legislative chambers, some offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. All legislative offices, other than the clerks and the legislative service agencies, are located in the Capitol. Legislative service agencies are in One East Main.
Wyoming	Legislative chambers, leaders' offices and committee rooms are located in the capitol. For all other legislators, their desk on the floor of the legislative chamber is considered their office. The Legislative Service office is also located in the capitol. (Capitol is currently undergoing restoration. All occupants have been moved to a temporary location.)
